BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Yamin Shahriar Chowdhury is working as Assistant Professor of Pediatric Neurology in the National Institute of Neurosciences & Hospital (NINS & H), Bangladesh. He has been working in this hospital since November, 2013. He was born in Dhaka in 1969. He passed SSC from West End High School and HSC from Notre Dame College, Dhaka in 1984 and 1986 respectively. He passed MBBS from Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College in 1994. He joined Government service through 17th BCS in 1997 as Assistant Surgeon. He served in different rural areas for more than five years. He completed his postgraduate training from Dhaka Medical College, Sir Salimullah Medical College and Institute of Child & Mother Health (ICMH). He worked as a Commonwealth Volunteer in tsunami affected areas of Maldives in 2005-06. He completed MD (Pediatrics) from Sir Salimullah Medical College under Dhaka University in 2011. He then went for advanced training in Pediatric Epilepsy and Electroencephalogram (EEG) to USA in 2013 from Boston Children's Hospital, Massachusetts which is the No. 1 children's hospital in US till 2020. After coming back, he joined his present working place as Assistant Professor in the Department of Pediatric Neurology. He also successfully completed online EEG training courses (VIREPA-Virtual Epilepsy Academy) organized by International League against Epilepsy (ILAE). He finished Basic EEG in 2014 and Pediatric EEG in 2015. He has been doing the reports of Pediatric EEGs in the Department of Neurophysiology of NINS & H. He has 7 (seven) publications in different international and national journals.
